

### **Navigating Financial Success and Cyber Security**

The Golden Connections Community Center has partnered with George Dillman from the Pennsylvania Department of Banking and Securities throughout 2023 to offer a series of presentations to assist seniors in determining the difficult task of navigating financial success and cyber security. #### **Eligibility:**

Must show proof of AGE & RESIDENCY at distribution site (Driver's license or PA ID are recommended)

- Must be 60 years of age by December 31, 2023
- Must be a York County Resident
- 2023 Gross Annual Income must be no more than:
  - \$26, 973 (\$2,248/month) for individual
  - \$36,482 (\$3,040/month) for a 2-person household
  - \$45,991 (\$3,833/month) for a 3-person household
